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Welcome

Located in the lovely village of Headley in Surrey, The Cock Inn is little more than a hop, skip and jump from Epsom, Reigate, Dorking and Leatherhead and not far from the M25 for those Londoners looking for a weekend escape to the country. It's an area of outstanding natural beauty with some fab walks to help you work up an appetite too! We are part of a family that is passionate about pubs, and we pride ourselves on sourcing local, quality ingredients to serve exceptional food and drink, in a relaxed and authentic pub environment.

Getting Here

Located in the centre of Headley village on church lane. The nearest train station is Leatherhead 3.7 miles away.

The nearest bus stop is directly out the front of the pub on church lane, Headley church, bus route 21. Timetables can be found on the surrey county council website. Local taxi, including wheelchair friendly. Clocktower Cars 01372 747 747

Car Parking

The pub has a large car park on site, directly next to the pub. The entrance/exit is from church lane. The lower parking area has 40 plus spaces and further 20 spaces in the upper car park, including 2 designated disabled marked bays.

The upper area is via a short incline from the lower car park. Access to the pub from the upper car park is a gentle incline through the patio garden.

From the lower car park, up to the patio area is 8 steps, the steps are 16cm high and 30 cm wide. The steps are lit at night and has a hand rail.





Arrival

The pub patio area surrounds the front of the pub and is on 2 levels. The first is accessed via the step or the incline. The second is 6 steps up or a wheelchair accessible lift. The lift height change is 94cm. The lift is 98cm wide and 132cm long.



The main entrance is double glass pull doors. These are 165cm wide when latched open. There is a small 2 cm high lip into the porch area. The porch area is 211cm long to the second set of double pull doors. This area is well lit inside and out.



Bar and Restaurant

The bar and majority of the restaurant is dark wood flooring. The bar is 106cm tall with overhead hanging and ceiling spot lighting. The tables in the bar area are tall with bench and chair seating.

There is a television next to our bar area, which we mostly use for marketing purposes to let you know about all our great offers. Occasionally we may use this to show some sporting events, however we will always have the sound turned off and the subtitles on if requested.



There is background music playing throughout the restaurant which can be adjusted. We do not have a hearing loop system

The restaurant is open plan with 2 raised and 1 lowered area. The maximum of 1 step to each of these areas with the step being no higher than 16cm.

We can swap chairs, or remove them completely depending on your needs when you are dining with us. We have a variety of wooden chairs, cushioned chairs, benches and booths in the different areas, so we are confident we will be able to find something that is most comfortable for you. Highchairs are also available to be added to tables.

Full table service is available throughout the bar and restaurant for drinks and food. The daily specials are written up on blackboards in the restaurant.

Our menus and daily specials can be viewed in larger formats on our iPads, a member of staff will be more than happy to help you with this.



We offer a gluten free menu, and have full allergen information available on request for our menus and daily specials. If you have any specific dietary requirements, please inform a member of staff on arrival, or prior to your visit, so our chefs can cater for you and ensure we can provide something exciting for you to enjoy.



We offer a private dining area, The Derby Room. This is a carpeted room with mixed tables, chairs and a bench seat. This room is on the entrance level to the pub. The door is 140cm wide when latched open. It has access to the toilets via side door and some steps and a narrow hall. The narrowest point of the hall is 68cm wide.

Restrooms

The door to access the customer restrooms is on the right-hand side of the bar. The door is 74cm wide and pushes inwards to a tiled flooring hallway. The disabled access toilet and ladies are on the restaurant floor level. The hallway to them at its narrowest is 77cm wide.

The disables access toilet door is 95cm wide. Inside is baby changing facilities. The toilet height is 48cm from the floor and has a back rest, grab rails and a fold down support bar.

An assistance required pull cord system is in operation as well as a red flashing fire alarm light within the toilet.



The men's restroom is down 2 steps on a corner turn. The steps are 21cm high and 26cm to 70cm wide. The restroom has 2 urinals (62cm high) and 2 cubicles. The flooring is the blue and white checked tiles. Music is played in both the ladies and gents restrooms. The ladies' toilet has 3 cubicles and is lit with ceiling spot lights. Feminine hygiene bins are provided.

Patio

Our lovely patio for eating and drinking, has a mixture of picnic benches, wooden tables with chairs and Rattan garden sofas. The table height ranges from 41cm to 72cm. The patio surface is large paving and is even throughout. One side area of the upper patio is decking flooring. Music is played on the patio and is lit at night. CCTV is in operation.



Additional Information

We welcome all dogs in the pub, including assistance dogs. If you have an assistance dog and require any help, then please let a member of staff know.

There are no facilities to charge mobility scooters or battery powered wheelchairs.

There is free Wi-Fi throughout the pub.

The closest accident and emergency hospital is 3.2 miles miles away.

Evacuation Procedure

Fire exit signs and extinguishers are visible around the pub also signage is placed in areas which are used as fire assembly points. Should a fire arise all staff are trained in the evacuation procedure including checking the toilets to ensure all customers and staff exit safely.
